DEVELOPMENT: Three shafts and several prospects

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The major mine workings consist of three shafts that explore the same arcuate fault vein system, bearing near N50-60°W and dip from 50-90°NE. The vein is approximately 3-5 feet wide with stringers and pods of vuggy, iron and manganese stained quartz in what is reported to be a diorite. The sample was selected from the dumps and consisted of minor copper oxides and sulfides of silver and galena.
