GEOLOGY: An E-W vein in metavolcanics has been explored by 3 shaft that are now caved, prospects and trenches in metavolcanics very near a contact with granite. The vein is traceable on the surface for 3-4 hundred yards. The vein maybe 4-6 feet wide in places, and dips to the south as much as 70°. Alteration extends from the vein into the country with silica veinlets minor brecciation and iron-oxide, bleached red. Float and dump material include garnet and epidote contact minerals although the contact zone was observed in the workings. Sample 3166 was chipped from the vein and selected from the dumps.
