DEVELOPMENT: Four adits the biggest about 50 feet long, one above the other on the lower westside of the range. Water from the lower adit is being piped to a animal trough in the botton of Lodi Valley.

GEOLOGY: The workings explore a S70°E bearing vertical shear with 6"-12" vein composed mostly of quartz stringers containing some pyrite. There are no roads to the workings and they apparently did not develop ore. Sample 3174 was a composite of the best looking ore from the veins and dumps.
