HISTORY: Reported to have been working prior to
1945 as a partnership by three men from
Gabbs. Has not been worked for many years.

DEVELOPMENT: A 100ft adit and a 60 foot caved shaft, small 25ft shaft and 15ft adit
and another 50 tunnel.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Recent staking by Placer Inc.

GEOLOGY: Workings in canyon consist of the big 100ft adit and 60ft shaft that
explore a quartz vein in dolomite and shale bearing N30°E dipping to
the west. The vein is about 12" wide highly oxidized and was apparently
dug and sorted by hand. Sample 3175 from lower workings had visible
galena and possible silver mineralization as well as pyrite, and minor
alteration except for iron-oxides. The upper workings are on a vein
in a shear that can be traced along the ridge for 3-4 hundred feet.
The vein is dolomite that has been intruded by dark-gray volcanics.
Sample 3176 is from the upper workings and consist of a highly oxidized
limonite stained vuggy but narrow quartz vein with visible galena clots
and reported gold values.
