DEVELOPMENT: Small scale leach operation & open pit mine. Several old stone structures, including the remains

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Leaching ore.

GEOLOGY: A small leach operation is located in Secret Canyon in the vicinity of old Geddes workings. They were not having ore at the time of examination but were currently leaching ore on leach pads. (cyanide) The ore apparently comes from the Geddes Mine.

The host rock at the Geddes Mine is the Geddes Limestone. At the Geddes Mine we found a small scale open pit which explores old, original workings. Sample 434 was taken from altered carbonate rock within the open pit.
