ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Prospect is located in SE corner of S29 & is symbolized as a shaft on the map. However, there is no dump to indicate a shaft ever existed.

The small propect explores a grey dolomitic limestone. Breccia with small calcite coated fractures also occurs in the area.

The prospect up the hill to south (on map) was not visited.
