GEOLOGY: Country rock medium gray crystalline limestone/dolomite Fe-Cu stained galena, possible with silver finely disseminated throughout limonite stained gossan. *Limestone/dolomite sheared and no apparent bedding plane, massive site consists of 2 dog holes, stoped shaft, and prospect pit along a line trending N15W. One shaft vertical with irregular shaped collar. The adjacent 40 inclined shaft dips N80W along fault plane. Vertical shaft appear to follow vertical fault zone.
