LOCATION

Fair Play Mining District, Nye County, Nevada, 40 miles northeast of Mina.

GEOLOGY

Areal geology consists of andesite flows cut by rhyolite dikes. The property is located along the strike of one of the rhyolite dikes which varies in width from 20 to 100 feet. Mineralization is found on either wall of the dike and consists of vein quartz over widths of 2 to 10 feet, containing erratic values in gold and silver.

DEVELOPMENT

Most favorable mineralized showing has been developed by 280-foot incline shaft, from which levels have been turned at the 150, 225, and 280-foot horizons. On the 150-foot level about 100 feet of drifting has been done, as well as a small amount of raising and winzing. On the 225-foot level there is about 300 feet of drifting, from which some stoping has been done, and from which a 50-foot raise has been driven. There is 80 feet of drifting on the 280-foot level. Portions of the underground work are inaccessible. Sampling of the accessible portions of the 150-foot level showed several erratic high-grade samples having no significance. Sampling of the 225-foot level and 280-foot level indicated no mineralization of interest.
