ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drilling in the general area by FMC

GEOLOGY: Locally the metasediments and metavolcanics are in contact. They have been cut by narrow veins and veinlets of quartz and in part have silicified the country rock. It appears that the N70E, 60NW vein that the incline is on follows a fault with the same inclination. There is strong iron-oxides after pyrite within the system. Sample 2089 was selected from the dumps and along the vein. Assay values showed 15ppm Au, 700ppm As and generally low values for the other elements.
