DEVELOPMENT: Several shafts, one 40 feet deep, 140 foot main shaft and 70 foot B shaft.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Host rocks are mostly andesite cut by quartz veins and rhyolite dike. The main workings are along a N30W, 60SW fault vein system that is up to 3 feet wide in places. Other workings are also aligned near and along the same vein system. Sample 2093 was taken from the dump near the main shaft, and consisted of quartz vein and altered vein material with secondary opaline quartz that was in places vuggy and brecciated, some pyrite and unidentified sulfides. Assay values showed very moderate values for silver-copper-lead.
