GEOLOGY: The big shaft follows a fault-vein bearing N40°W, 80°E in highly silicified dacite(?) that is propylitized and iron-stained from oxidizing pyrite. Several similar shallower shafts dot the landscape within a half mile radius. Sample 2097 was taken from dumps and prospects and had anomalous values in copper, lead, zinc, silver 1000ppm.
