DEVELOPMENT: A line of caved prospects

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, area near workings recently staked (Lucky Four Claims).

GEOLOGY: A line of caved prospects follows narrow veins and veinlets in deeply weathered granite (not shown on the county map). The strike and dip of the veins is highly irregular but the mineralization seems quite uniform, consisting of galena, tetrahedrite, chalcopryrite and sphalerite. The granite exposed here is probably responsible for the skarn which has been explored for tungsten in the mines to the south. Sample 3871 contained 2000 ppm copper, 2000 ppm molybdenum, 5 ppm silver and less than .05 ppm gold.
