GEOLOGY: The prospect is a small trench and a small now-caved adit that explores a 3-to 4-foot thick white quartz vein in an outcrop of older sediments. The vein bears N65°W and stands vertically. Sample 3821 was chipped from the exposed portion of the vein which showed only minor gray sulfides. Tenneco sample #4-8265 was taken from this same location.
