Subject: Schedule of Work

Dear Mr. Stephenson:

It would be appreciated if you would schedule the following work at your convenience:

- #1. It has been arranged for Mr. Dixon to meet you at Middlegate, Nevada. Mr. Fredricks will also meet you at 8:30 A.M., April 6, 1970. As per our discussion, you will make a plane table survey and a geological report and take samples of the Buffalo Hump property Southeast of Middlegate.
- #2. After your work is completed at Buffalo Hump, I would recommend that you accompany Mr. Dixon and Mr. Fredricks to Fairview Mining District and review the mining claims owned by the Hughes Tool Company with Mr. Dixon and supervise sample taking by Mr. Fredricks. It is desirable to have drilling sites located for the assessment work that will obtain the best geological information for the funds expended.

During your work at Fairview, it would be appreciated if you would also review the Lager and Bill Irons claims and report your recommendations to this office.

- #3. At your earliest convenience, after the above work is completed, there are four properties in the vicinity of Battle Mountain that this office is very anxious to have you inspect, evaluate, and recommend drill holes for assessment work and exploration.
