Dear Mr. LaVey:

We regret to inform you that we have no information on the Dead Cedar Mining property in the Allegheny Mining District, more commonly known as the Ferguson Spring District.

This district is at Ferguson Springs on the west side of the Goshute mountains near White Horse or Don-Don Pass, approximately 30 miles south-southwest of Wendover, Utah.

The deposits have been known since the late 1880's. Minor activity occurred in 1910 and 1912 and a small amount of production was recorded for the years for the years 1917, 1937, and 1939. The deposits are oxidized irregular replacement bodies of copper with traces of silver and lead. Limonite, barite and quarts form the gangue. Mineralization follows bedding and east-west fractures.
