ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: At least 3 recent drill holes.

GEOLOGY: Fe-Mg stained breccia with oxidized pyrite and crystalline calcite cementing breccia Limestone. Cu disseminated throughout breccia cement. Breccia is brecciated. Some silicia. Smithsonite?

Site consists of 3 areas: 1) inclined caved shaft trending N67E 2) Small shaft 6x4x15 and 3) Small, all along trend. Inclined shaft has 2 cave-ins, 2 shallow shafts, caved. Remains of old house. Vertical shaft SW \approx 50' of workings, old timbers, small amount of Cu-Fe, mostly Limestone.

Lamping shows large sprays of scheelite.
Very minor moly.
