GEOLOGY: Country rock med-grey crystalline, laminated (med. bedding 1-2 ft. thick) dolomite/  
Limestone. Localized attitude N15W, 30NE, however, area faulted and sheared so bedding  
irrelevant. FeOx stained Limestone breccia, calcite cemented, Sb oxides, Cu staining,  
very minor mineralization. Small amount pyrite and yellow oxides.

Entire Rose Mine vicinity consists of possibly 1000 ft. of workings, a dozen shafts  
(vertical and inclined) adits and uncountable dog holes. At least 5 miles of drill roads  
(with holes) and prospect roads. Age of working from 80 to 1 year old. (Box found dated 1907  
Most of diggings shallow and some caved. Some rock type throughout.
