ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Med-grey, fine-grained Limestone dipping NE, large amount calcite cemented breccia. Quartzite in float. Allegedly Fluorite and beryl in vein material, but none observed. MnO<sub>2</sub> stains, Limestone silicic with brown-purple stains. FeOx on fractures. Silicic veins and filling vugs.

Site consists of 2 vertical shafts, 50 feet apart and one prospect pit. No other development other than remains of stone building. Upper shaft irregular shaped 20-25' deep could be caved. Stone building between shaft. Trenching at least 5 years old, east of workings.
