GEOLOGY: Opalite along N70°E, bleached, silicified, shear zone area is roughly on trend of the N30°E shear zone seen at the Wild Rose Mine. There are several pits & cuts over about 1/2 mile on the N70°E structure, wall rock bleached volcanic, zone resembles old hot springs system, up to 3' thicknesses of chalcedonic silica with vugs & laced with quartz veinlets & some disseminated pyrite occur along structure, in places, rock appears to have been brecciated, recemented with silica.
