DEVELOPMENT:

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, drilling prouect in past 1-2 years.

GEOLOGY: Vein strikes N-S to N10°W, 65°E dip, 10'-15' wide, lamellar quartz, banded, fine-grained black sulfides as thin crustifications wall rock silicified, brecciated latite(?), outcrop stained tan & brick red, some Mn oxides.

Vein outcrop on ridge north of open stopes highly silicified, Feox stained, sheeting & veining here follow N30°E trend, but stoped vein (N-S structure) appears to intersect N30°E structure.

REMARKS: Vein has been stoped to surface in area above (North of) the old stamp mill which is still on the property, there is a considerable volume of tailings down stream from the mill. Recent drilling has explored the hangingwall & footwall of the vein structure to the southwest along strike.
