GEOLOGY: East-west trending fault zone, near vertical fault zone in buff-colored, silicated limestone. Gossan zone explored by workings has formed at the intersection of the fault and a N20-30E, 85NW cross-fracture. gossan zone rakes down along the intersection.

REMARKS: The massive limestone that forms the top of the hill is silicated, bleached to a dull buff color.
Sample 2214 taken of cellular gossan and jasperoid from shaft dump, crystals of hemimorphite fill vugs in the gossan.
