GEOLOGY: N10-20W, 45-55NE dipping shear zone in altered andesite(?), thin pods of white vein quartz occur along the structure, vein zone up to 6" wide, vein is Feox-stained, vuggy, with sparse clots of tetrahedrite, some green and blue copper oxide staining. The shear zone extends for 700'-1000' along strike to the northwest, bleaching and alteration in wall rocks extends 100'-200' beyond walls of vein, volcanic rock is propylitized and kaolinized.

REMARKS: Workings appear to be very old, hand-hewn timbers, square nails, etc., but property was lived on up into the 1940's or later.
