GEOLOGY: 4'-6' thick band of limonite/hematite gossan along N40W, 85SW dipping shear zone in limestone. Zone is conformable to strike and dip of limestone bedding, limestone is thin-bedded, mottled grey, walls of shear zone laced with veinlets of white calcite, some white marble patches. The three shallow prospects follow the strike of the gossan zone, dumps are mainly gossan material. A and of sooty grey-black tremolite rich limestone crops out about 20' down-section from the gossan zone. Tremolite band is about 10' thick.
