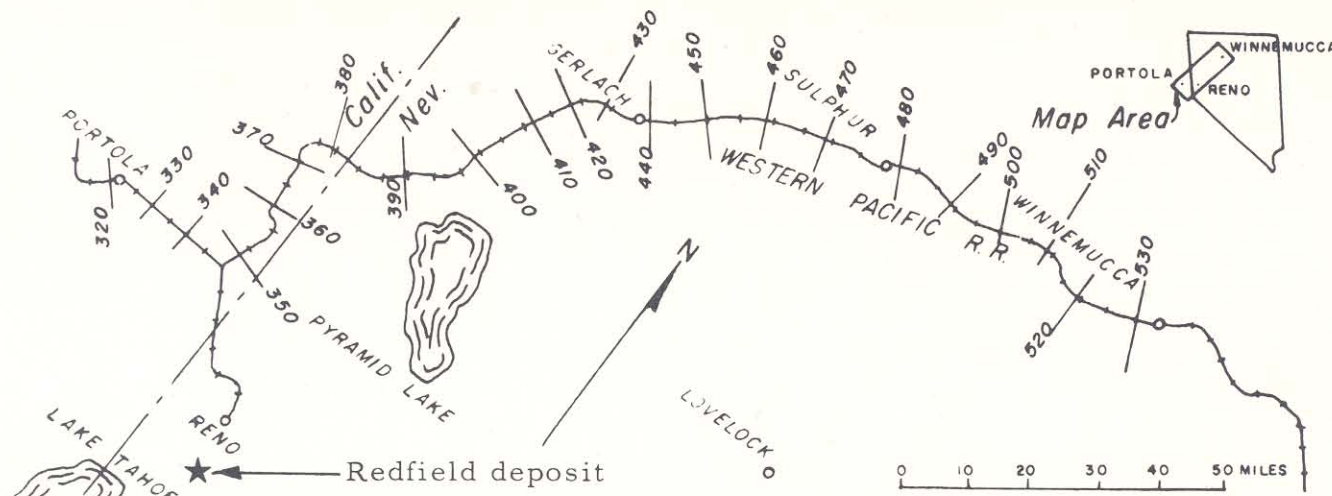

## DESCRIPTION:

Excellent quality rather homogeneous pumicite; white to very light gray. Forms hill.

## RESERVES:

Medium (not half as large as Naturalite deposit but quality is just as good).

## ACCESS:

Two miles by unimproved road to pavement then ten miles north.

## OWNERSHIP:

Entire section owned by millionaire L. V. Redfield of Reno under name of his relative H. B. R. Bushard (sister?).

## SOURCES OF DATA:

## ECONOMICS:

Close to market - very little in way of housing nearby. High quality; has been trenched here and there.
