Dear Don:

When I was talking with Bill Hart several days ago, on the telephone, I mentioned the Willow Creek area located near Winnimucca, Nevada. You and I have talked about it.

As you know, this is a gold prospect, of over 400 acres, in the Willow Creek area in Pershing County, Nevada. It is in the East Range about 30 miles s150W of Winnemucca. The property is held by a Dr. Caller Sr. of 348 W. 3rd St in Winnemucca, Nevada.






