LOCATION OF PROPERTY

Pine Nut Range, Douglas County, Nevada, 3 miles by highway and 7 miles by  
mountain road from Gardnerville, Nevada.

GEOLOGY

Metamorphosed Mesozoic sedimentary rocks occurring in an anticlinal fold  
(Axis  $\nearrow$  N.  $35^{\circ}$  W. - Dips  $35^{\circ}$  W. and E.). Dikes and sills of granitic rock  
occur indiscriminately throughout the mass. Economic mineral, scheelite,  
occurs in the altered areas near quartz seams.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Property consists of 11 unpatented claims. Principal mine workings, con-  
sisting of a 120 foot tunnel, inclined shaft, and irregular stope below the  
tunnel level, are located on the Fawn and Badger claims. The incline shaft  
which intersected the tunnel is reported to have been sunk  $\nearrow$  200 feet. This  
shaft is caved below the 66 foot mark.
