NAME OF PROPERTY

Tungston Hills Mining Company -

LOCATION OF PROPERTY

Pine Nut Range, Douglas County, Nevada, 3 miles by highway and 7 miles by mountain road from Gardnerville, Nevada.

GEOLOGY

Metamorphosed Mesozoic sedimentary rocks occurring in an anticlinal fold (Axis / N. 35° W. - Dips 35° W. and E.). Dikes and sills of granitic rock occur indiscriminately throughout the mass. Economic mineral, schoolite, occurs in the altered areas near quarts seams.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Property consists of 11 unpatented claims. Principal mine workings, consisting of a 120 foot turnel, inclined shaft, and irregular stope below the tunnel level, are located on the Faun and Badger claims. The incline shaft which intersected the tunnel is reported to have been sunk \(\sum_{\text{200}} \) foot. This shaft is caved below the 66 foot mark.
