NAME OF PROPERTY

Bataan Copper

T7N/R33E

LOCATION

On Garfield Mountain, 17 miles southeast of Mina, Nevada - Mineral County.

GEOLOGY

Limestone in contact with a basic intrusive, and cut by a fault fissure.

DESCRIPTION

Oxidized copper ores formed at intersection of fault fissure and contact. Mining by glory hole or open pit method during World War I resulted in an excavation about 75 feet in diameter and 50 feet deep, at which depth the ore was bottomed. None remains in any appreciable quantity.
