**Location.** The Gass Peak District is situated on Gass Peak at the S. end of the Las Vegas Range in central Clark Co. The town of Las Vegas on the U. P. R. R. is 18 m. to the S.

**History.** The principal mine is that of the June Bug Dev. Co., Inc., of which

L. S. Scoville of Ogden, Utah, is Pres. Nearly \$38,000 worth of ore was shipped from this mine in 1916 and 1917.

**Geology.** Zinc silicate ore containing values in silver and gold is said to occur in shoots in veins in Paleozoic limestone.
