## GEYSER MINE

The Geyser Mine is about 4 miles west of the Geyser Ranch, on the east side of the Schell Creek Range at an altitude of about 9,000 feet, near the White Pine County Mine. Tschanz (1970) describes the deposit as a quartz vein in the Prospect Mountain Quartzite with hubnerite (wolframite?) and silver minerals. An old stamp mill on the property was probably used to extract the silver-bearing minerals. The ore assays up to 0.9 percent WO<sub>3</sub> but there is no record of any tungsten production.

Florito occurs in the vein as a gangus mired.
