LOCATION

Five miles west of U. S. Highway No. 93 on Sheep Creek, on the east slope  
of the Schell Creek Range in southern White Pine County, Nevada.

GEOLOGY

Cambrian sedimentary rocks - limestones, quartzites and shales, dipping  
steeply to the east. A quartz vein, containing hubnerite ranging up to 4 feet  
wide, occurs in a more or less silicified member of the shale beds.

DEVELOPMENT

This consists of a short tunnel (25 feet) and numerous surface cuts on the  
vein along the croppings for about 450 feet. Samples taken indicate tungstic  
acid content ranges from 0.13% up to 0.52%.
