GEOLOGY: Site is a vertical shaft, approximately 100 feet, in fine-grained, light gray, silicious rock, (Tert. rhyolite breccia?), with yellow oxides coating surfaces. Rock cut with pyrite bearing quartz veins and veinlets. Appears to be stockwork veining. Vein also has pyrite ghosts, boxworks, gossany areas. Pyrite also appears in gouge material on dump. Workings follow north trend along range front. Abundant Fe-Mn staining. Quartz vein vitreous, white to gray, with silicified fragments of rhyolite breccia. Vuggy, Quartz also cuts chert, possibly from Ord. Palmetto Formation.
