DEVELOPMENT:

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Recently been drilled, sampled, mapped, etc.

GEOLOGY: Sample 1278 taken from northern most adit. Dump composed of heavily Fe-Mn gossan, stained with quartz veins bearing pods of moly. Garnetiferous-epidote tactite in float, thinly tabular crystals of gypsum. Area appears to be outcropping Palmetto Formation. Most of dump pyritic stained gossan. Outcrop above workings Fe stained, sugary quartzite, cut with massive white quartz veins. Stockworks, some breccia. Further upslope, medium gray mud/siltstone with brecciated quartz veins, rocks also cut with aplite dikes. At Sample Site 1279, approximately 100 yards south, pyrite is disseminated throughout a quartz rich igneous intrusive, which is also cut with brecciated, Fe stained quartz veins. No development of these prospects, however, area east and north has been recently (within last year) drilled, trenched, and sampled by Anaconda.
