ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION:

GEOLOGY: Workings sunk in punky, highly altered, fragment and lithic rich, silicious volcanics (rhyolite). Workings consist of at least 5 vertical shafts on a due north trend, with workings totaling probably 500 feet. The rocks are partially flow, partially ash fall, with moderate Fe-Mg staining. Chalcedonic quartz veins cut the volcanics, boxworks, crystals after calcite, drusy quartz coats vugs and fractures, calcedonic and opaline silica coat and cement breccia, mammalry hematite/limonite coat surfaces.\* Basalt in float. Abundant peripheral workings, recent dozing, possible assessment work.  
Some silicification of host rocks, pyrite ghosts, with possible mercury occurring in chalcedonic veins, Host rock possibly minor outcropping of Tertiary ash tuffs and rhyolite breccia
