GEOLOGY: Workings are in a line N75E, following a dike grading east to west from fine-grained aplitic alaskite to coarse-grained, biotite-rich pegmatite. East working dozer trench in alluvium, middle and west are shallow pits, the middle along a contact between massive quartz veins and fine-grained alaskite. The west pit is entirely in pegmatite. Quartz vein smokey, fractured, FeOx stained, minor sericite. Pegmatite cut by quartz veinlets, biotite oxidized. Veins and dike cut Oligocene Harrison Pass pluton. No mineralization was observed.
