REPORT ON  
BLAINE AND KASPER PROPERTY  
GOLCONDA, HUMBOLDT COUNTY, NEVADA.

Location:

This property consisting of four claims, known as the Dolmite No. 1, Dolmite No. 2, Dolmite No. 3 and Dolmite No. 4 is situated in Section 18, Township 40 East, Range 37 North, which lies about eight miles north-east of Golconda, Humboldt County, Nevada.

Geology & Ore Occurrence:

The vein occurs on a contact between black lime, hanging-wall and shale foot-wall. The vein is a hard fine-grained secondary quartz which strikes nearly north and south and dips east 28 to 30 degrees.

The value in the ore is mainly silver with a small amount of gold, copper and tungsten.

Title:

This property was located by Blaine and Kasper, of Golconda, about three months ago and is held by right of discovery and location.

Workings:

The workings consist of one tunnel 55 feet long to crosscut the vein, which upon striking the vein turns into an incline 55 feet deep and is known as the Kasper incline. To the north of the Kasper incline there are two short inclines, one 38 feet deep and one still further north 10 feet deep.

### Equipment:

The equipment consists of a windlass, some hand mining tools and a small blacksmith shop.

### Production:

There is between 100 and 125 tons of ore on the dump that will assay between 8 and 10 ounces silver a ton.

### Terms:

Purchase price \$25,000.00; payments \$500.00 to \$1000.00 down, balance in six months, twelve months and eighteen months. Ninety shifts a month, all ore to be left on dump. Mr. Moore has an option on the property at present which he has offered to sell thru Mr. John T. McCall of Golconda.

### Conclusions:

Owing to the short length of the vein, the low general average of the values and the excessive terms, the property is not

worthy of further consideration.
