GOLCONDA, HUMBOLDT COUNTY, NEVADA.

LOCATION

This group of four claims is located in Section 8, R. 38 N., T. 39 E., about ten miles north of Golconda in the Paradise Mining District, Humboldt County, Nevada.

CLAIMS

There are four full claims known as the Ford, Ford No.1, Ford No. 2 and Ford No. 3.

OWNERSHIP AND TITLE

This group is held by right of discovery and location. The owners are W. M. Snyder, W. Miking and Wm. Curley.

FACILITIES:

Transportation. All freight and supplies must be hauled over a good desert road from Golconda, a distance of ten miles.

Power. There is no electric power in the country and no wood for fuel so fuel oil would have to be depended upon for power.

Water. Water for domestic and mill purposes must be developed in the flat country about a mile south of the property, where it is reported that water can be obtained in large quantities at ten feet in depth.

TOPOGRAPHY

The nature of this country is flat and rolling, requiring shafts for development of any prospect.

GEOLOGY

General. The geology of this section consists of lime and shale cut by several quartz porphyry dikes. The lime and shales dip to the East, while the porphyry dikes strike approximately East and West.

Local. About the center of the Ford claim there is a contact between the shale and quartz porphyry which also crosses the Ford No. 1 and Ford No. 2 claims. Along this contact and in the small fractures in the porphyry close to the contact are small stringers of galena with a small amount of copper carbonate.

DEVELOPMENT

The development consists of a tunnel about 50 feet long and a drift 15 feet long on the ore about 20 feet under the surface.

EQUIPMENT

The equipment consists of a blacksmith outfit and one small cabin.

PRODUCTION

The prospectors who own this property have mined about thirty tons of good ore by chloriding the streaks. A grab sample of their ore pile showed a trace of gold, 1.90 ozs. silver and 32.7 per cent lead. Figuring lead at 8 cents a pound gives a value of \$54.22 a ton.

SAMPLING

A small stope 8 feet above the level was just started at the time of visit and showed a streak of ore 1 foot wide and 10 feet long. Two holes had just been shot in the ore so a grab sample of the muck shot down showed a trace of gold, 1.70 ozs. silver and 37.1 per cent lead, giving a total value of \$61.06 a ton - lead at 8 cents.

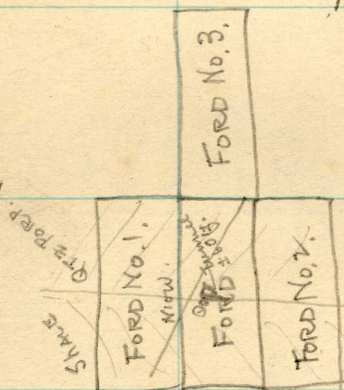
