DEVELOPMENT: Small bulldozer cut.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Copper and minor manganese-oxide minerals occur in quartzite and sparse quartz vein matter at a minor prospect. Pyrite was noted in some samples. The copper mineral is chrysocolla. The prospect is shown by Erickson and Marsh (1974) on an east-west high-angle fault which separates Preble Formation (Cambrian) from Permian Edna Mountain Formation. A yellow green encrustation may be an arsenate. Prospects 0.5 km to north (topo map) are apparently for location work only (Golconda No. 3 claim).

REMARKS: Photo LG 842 - 1 is of the small trench. Sample 2311 is a grab of quartzite and vein matter with copper-oxide minerals.
