23. Gold Basin (Rowland district. Placers were ~~reportedly~~ worked prior to 1900 and in 1931, along the north fork of the Bruneau River in the vicinity of Rowland (T. 47 N., R. 56 E.), but no production has been recorded from the area.

Paher, 1970: States placer gold discovered on Bruneau River in 1869.
