DEVELOPMENT: Complete mining operation set up from initial placer operation to milling, processing assaying, to molding into bars, largest operation in area, air strip, houses, animals,

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Actively placer mining, supports 5 persons

GEOLOGY: Mr. Bozell was kind enough to give me a tour of his operation, but did not permit the taking of samples or photos. The operation at the mine is currently placer, since the old shafts are either caved or flooded, at one point, the quartz vein which had previously produced the ore, was exposed, approximately 6 inches wide, vertical, trending E-W, abundant open spacing, FeOx stained, cutting Pre Cambrian granitic gneiss. Mr. Bozell's sons were placer mining that day. The site has an active mill, cyanidization plant, assay office, and small geochemical lab, all functional. He is actively mining approximately 200 acres and holds the claim on an additional 5000 acres.
