

Lone Mountain (Baker) — GOLD BUTTE DIST.

The Baker claims are 5 miles west of Lovelock on the westernmost of several small knolls known as Lone Mountain, Lovelock quadrangle. This knoll is composed of granite that rises above the alluvial slope on the east side of the Trinity Range. Over a roughly circular area with a diameter of about 200 feet, scheelite is found disseminated in the granite along fractures and in quartz veinlets. The average grade of the material is estimated at 0.1 to 0.15 percent of WO_3
