Photo Tingley #2, 24 (granite on left quartz vein on right photo #25 of stockworking Tingley thought he saw some huebernite. Standing water in fault area. Stockworking fault area. Stockworking in intrusive possibly continuation of veining in intrusive porphyry at Sample Site 863. Enter area cut with drill roads, dozer cuts. Hasn't been worked in 2 years.
