Surrounding the site the quartz monzonite of the pluton outcrops. Relations suggests that sediments could be remnant of roof pediment. The sediments exhibit bedding plane faults, with a set of intersecting shears. The sediments are extensively fractured, and FeOx stained. While no quartz vein was observed in place, the dump consisted of vuggy quartz vein material carrying oxidized (and a little fresh) pyrite and chalcopyrite in pods, clots, and stringers. The vein was coated with FeOx stains and secondary silica (hyalite).
