DEVELOPMENT: Remains of old town, mill, extensive dumps (which look as if they have been reworked within last few years), leach ponds,

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, but people live on site

GEOLOGY: Workings and town situated in (and on) alluvium, few outcroppings of limestone/dolomite area mapped as Wyman Formation (PG). Sediments finely laminated (almost varve-like). Oxidized, brecciated quartz vein material on dump, carrying minor pyrite, some calcite veining. Possibly minor sphalerite in quartz vein. Gossany limestone, brecciated and cemented with quartz. Abundant Fe-Mn oxide stains, calcite and quartz fill vugs.
