PRELIMINARY REPORT ON  
Buck Board Group.

4 Name and Owner.

Location and Holdings. This group is five claims located in the south portion of the Horn Silver Mng. Dist. about five miles south of the town.

Accessibility and Transportation. There is a good road from the property to Stonewall station on the T. & T. R.R. a distance of about 20 miles.

Geology. The rock formation here is practically all sedimentary, shale, slate, quartzite and lime, the shale predominating. To the North an intrusion of monzonite with a small dike crossing the property.

Veins or Ore Bodies. There are a series of veins crossing the claims, all are small the largest being about three feet wide with an average of about one foot.

These veins are all quartz and calcite with quite plentiful limonite, carrying practically all silver value.

Samples and Assays.

1	3.8	Tr.	0.96	Cut across vein in old location hole on Buck Board claim. Near contact between lime and Monzonite.
2	1.4	Tr.	0.40	Cut across vein in 50 foot incline about 15 feet below surface. B.B. Claim. Vein in bedding plane. Quartz, limonite and spots of pyrite.
3	3.3	Tr.	0.26	10 ft. hole at monument of Buck Board claim. Development. crushed quartz in lime shale.

Development consists of numerous small pits and cuts with one incline down about fifty feet on a 25 degree pitch.

Present Equipment. There is no equipment.

Metallurgy.

Wood, Water and Power. The nearest water is from springs about three miles distant. Timber will all have to be imported. Power made by use of fuel oil engines.

Price and Terms. Purchase price \$10,000, Terms to suit.

Possibilities. There are no possibilities.
