They have been over run with geologists this summer; a few last year, bt not many compared to this. A crew of geophysicists was supposed to be out about now to work over property to north of camp (about the nickel hall, I guess) which is not owned by Hardy. Evidently no drilling has been done in area, and no formal geophysics; probably helicontersm were doing something, and probably has been some recon mag work. I saw no sign of any claim staking in area, and no sign of drilling or surveying of any kind.
