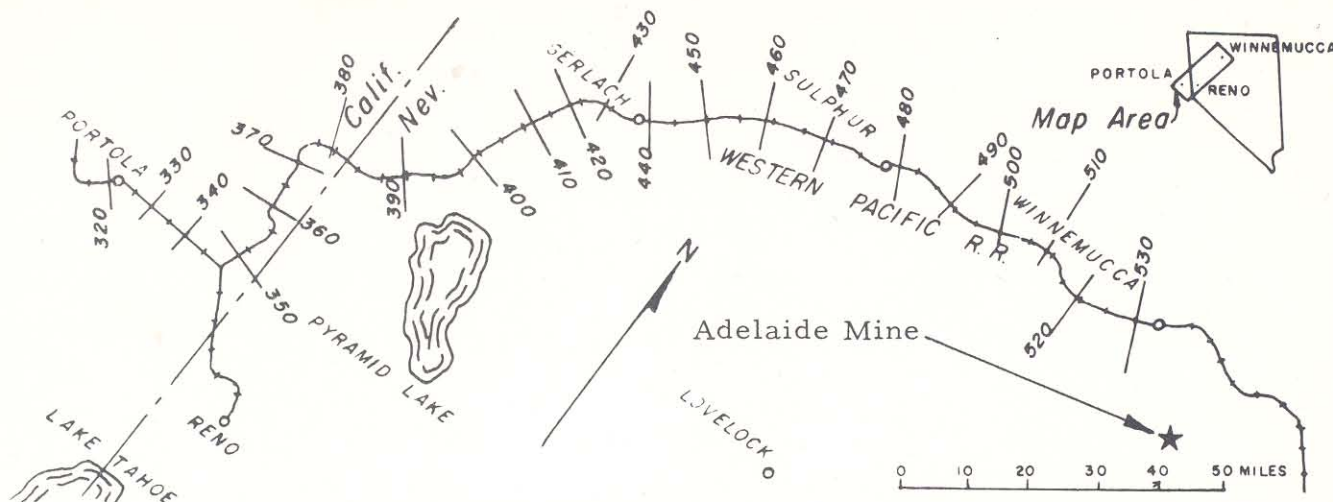

DESCRIPTION: Has yielded mostly copper ore. Country rock is dark calcareous phyllite and interbedded limestone which strike north and dip steeply east. The ore replaces limestone and consists of pyrrhotite, chalcopyrite, sphalerite, and galena in a gangue of silicates and carbonates. The ore bodies are erratically distributed throughout the limestone for 600 feet along the strike and 300 feet down dip.
