DEVELOPMENT: Two short adits.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Replacement bodies, consisting of garnet, idocrase?, pyrrhotite chalcopryrite and pyrite occur in the vicinity of a nearly horizontal thrust fault in Cambrian Prebble Formation. Rocks with original carbonate minerals are variably silicated. Bedding is N50E, 90°. A few specks of scheelite were observed with a black light in sample 2302.

REMARKS: Sample 2302 was collected as a select sample of sulfide-rich material from a dump.
