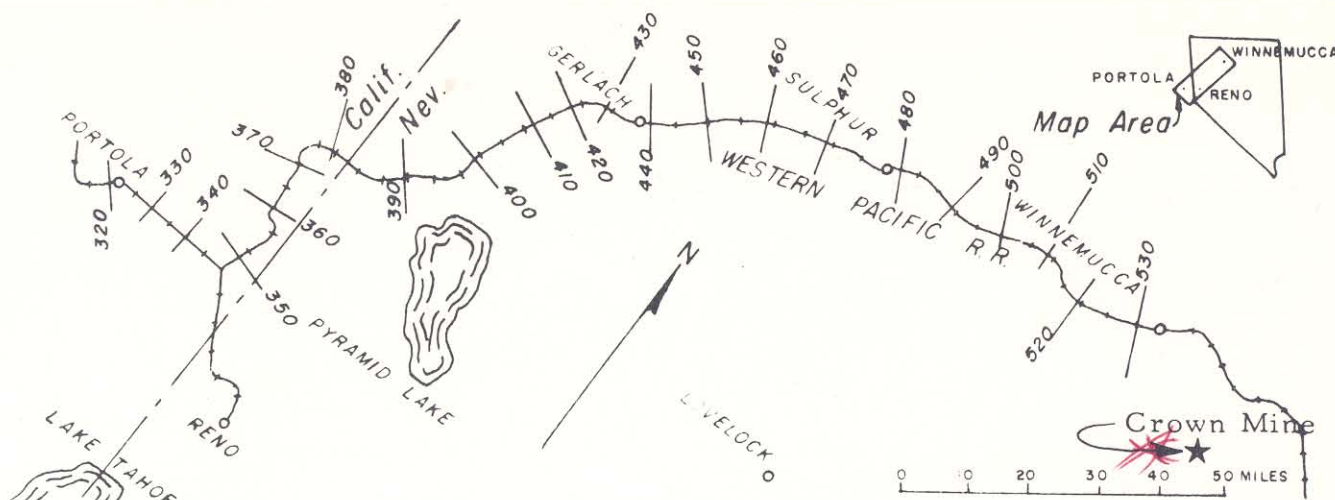

**DESCRIPTION:** First explored in 1920 with intermittent work since. In 1938 a cyanide mill was erected on the property. Production continued until 1941, but the value is not known. The country rock is shale and quartzite which are cut by a silicified fault zone that strikes northward. The fault zone has been mineralized over a width of 10 to 80 feet and is stained by iron and manganese oxides. The gold and silver tenor was reported to be \$4.00 to \$5.00 a ton in ore blocked out in 1938.
