History and production

This property is apparently a relocation of old claims which were located as gold and silver properties.

Type Deposit (Goeolgy)

The rocks in the district consist of granite schist and slate. Ore deposits containing gold, silver and some antimony are found in system of mineralized fault fissures which strike north and south and dip 65° to 70° west.

Mine Workings

The property contains numerous open pits and one 70 foot shaft. The best ore was found at the bottom of ike shaft. Here the ore is about 1 foot wide and assays 16.78% antimony.
